



Instructions after Egg Retrieval

Go directly home and rest today.

You should avoid inserting anything inside the vagina for 24 hours.

You may take Extra Strength Tylenol or Percocet for pain today. Do not take Motrin, Advil or any other nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drug (NSAID) for cramping.

Start taking Doxycycline, Prednisone and Prometrium tonight.

Start baby aspirin and Crinone/ Endometrin tomorrow.

Eat lightly today and drink plenty of fluid.

You can expect to have some abdominal cramping, bloating and vaginal spotting today.

You will get a call from Dr. Miller tomorrow letting you know how many of the eggs have fertilized normally. She will also tell you when the transfer will be (either three or five days after the retrieval).

While these problems are infrequent, reasons that you should call the office immediately:

- If you are bleeding and saturating a pad within one hour.
- If you are dizzy or passing out.
- If you have a fever (temperature > 100.5F).
- If you are vomiting and unable to keep down any liquids.
